What services do we provide?

We provide comprehensive contraception and sexual health services to men and women of all ages in our walk-in clinics.

We are committed to providing friendly, confidential and accessible services that include:

- All methods of contraception including condoms
- Emergency contraception
- Pregnancy tests
- Abortion information
- Cervical smears
- RUCLEAR Chlamydia screening programme (www.ruclear.co.uk)
- Testing for sexually transmitted infections, including HIV
- Dedicated FRESH services for young people aged under 25 (www.Fresh4manchester.com)
- Weekday telephone advice line for patients
- Reproductive health advice and referral.

In addition to our walk-in clinics, we also provide specialist services many of which are by appointment. Our specialist services include:

- Community colposcopy
- Vasectomy counselling and operations

- Psychosexual counselling
- Menopause care
- Treatment for uncomplicated sexually transmitted infections
- Outreach contraception services for clients with special needs
- Highly specialised contraception
- IUD and implant clinics.
